








1. Degree of Achievement and Outlook


a. Achievement of business objective

98.09 % of the respondents said that they were willing to participate again.
















2. Business success of the Travel Bazaar

Quality of the business queries received at GITB '23 and G20 Tourism Expo
















c. Which segments of Tourism do you promote?

The destinations in North and South India were the most popular for the buyers , closely followed by East/North - East and West India.


























The most discussed segment at GITB '23 and G20 Tourism Expo were FITs, Groups and MICE.
















6. Destinations discussed at GITB '23 and G20 Tourism Expo

The report highlights the present scenario of inbound tourism in India, the initiatives being undertaken by the Central & various State Governments to boost the sector, various niche tourism products introduced by Government of India, India's G20 Tourism priorities and Vision 2047 with respect to the tourism sector.

The future of inbound tourism in India looks promising, provided that the country continues to make efforts on multiple fronts to fully unlock the potential. Following are some of the majors which can help in accelerating the growth of Indian tourism industry:

- 1. Streamline visa processes: The visa process for foreign tourists can be a significant deterrent for those who are interested in visiting India. The government can work on simplifying the visa process by making it more accessible, user-friendly, and efficient.
- 2. Address safety concerns: Safety concerns, particularly for female travelers, continue to be a significant issue in India. The government can work on improving the safety of tourists by increasing the number of tourist police and introducing measures to prevent harassment and crimes against tourists.
- 3. Improve infrastructure: India needs to improve its infrastructure, including airports, roads, public transport, and accommodation, to make it easier for tourists to travel around the country. The government can work on improving infrastructure by investing in new facilities and upgrading existing ones.
- **4. 




